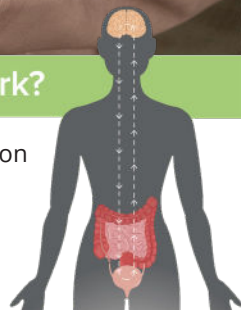

How Does Axonics Therapy Work?

Axonics Therapy provides gentle stimulation to the nerves that communicate between the brain, bladder & bowel. This helps restore normal communication which can result in symptom improvement.



Basic Trial (PNE)

A minimally invasive procedure that is often done in the office or surgery center and does not involve any incisions. The doctor will place one or two temporary leads and you get to trial the therapy for a few days. At the completion of the trial, the temporary lead(s) is removed and you and your physician will decide if the therapy is right for you. If the trial is successful, you'll schedule a second procedure to place the permanent lead and stimulator. If the trial is inconclusive your doctor may recommend trying an advanced trial.
